SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Lafayette College Photograph Collection (1858-) contains approximately 50,000 photographic images which document the history of the college. As such it provides a visual record of the development of Lafayette College. The collection is most valuable as a resource for photographs of individuals associated with the college, campus events, and the physical development of the buildings and grounds.

The collection (100 linear feet – 274 boxes) is organized into five series and contains photographs, lithographs, printed reproductions from publications, albums, negatives, and slides. The range of 19th-century photographic processes represented in the collection is dominated by the albumen print in the form of cartes-devisite and cabinet photos. Other processes found among the 19th-century photographs are mainly black and white prints, with color photos appearing more frequently after 1970.

Series I contains photographs of individuals and associated with Lafayette College. This includes, presidents, trustees, administrators, staff, faculty, honorary degree and citation recipients, and students. Group photos were organized into similar categories Series II, but have now been integrated into Series I and IV. Views of the campus and buildings are located in Series III. Series IV records the various activities and events that have taken place at the college and Series V contains athletic photographs. Oversize and extra-oversize photographs are arranged in boxes and folders at the end of each series and are cross-referenced within Series I - V. Series VI contains special formats which include albums, negatives, slides, glass plate negatives, lantern slides, stereocards and stereoscopes, and panoramic views.

An index to the collection is located at the end of the guide. Index entries refer to folder headings, such as building names, events, activities, organizations, and sports. The index also includes entries for all publications within the collection containing photographic images as well as all photograph albums listed alphabetically by owner's last name.

NOTE ON PROVENANCE

The Lafayette College Photograph Collection is comprised of photographic materials acquired from various campus locations. Much of the material found in Series I and IV is provided by college administrative offices such as Alumni Affairs and Public Information Office. The rest of the collection contains photographs which were found in the college archives located in Kirby Hall, Van Wickle Hall attic, and Skillman Library's Special Collections. Some 19th-century photographs were donated by alumni, administrators, and other individuals who have been associated with the college or the Easton area.

INVENTORY

SERIES I - INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS: 1858 -

Series I (91 boxes) contains photographs of individuals and groups who are associated with Lafayette College. Individuals are arranged within the series according to their relationship with the college: presidents, trustees, faculty and staff, honorary degree and citation recipients, and students. With the exception of students, the photographs are organized alphabetically within each group. Students are organized into classes and then alphabetically within their class. Individuals who may fall into more than one category are filed with the group which represents their most resent position at the college; i.e. a faculty member who earned his/her degree at Lafayette College will be found within the faculty group of Series I.

Student photographs include shots of individuals while they attended Lafayette and as alumni. Photographs of students span the classes of 1834 to the present. There are no surviving individual photographs for the classes of 1835, 1839, 1841-42, 1854, 1867, and 1869. In 1857 the first lithograph series appears in the collection. Prior to this year, existing photographs of students were taken as alumni. This is the first indication in the collection that students were having their individual portraits taken together as a class, by the same photographer or lithographer. The 1854 minutes of the Franklin Literary Society, one of the two 19th-century debating clubs at Lafayette College, indicate that the daguerreotypes of senior members were collected each year; sadly, these early photographs must have been destroyed in the 1879 Pardee Hall fire.

The class of 1858 file represents the earliest photographs of the collection in the form of a salted paper print series. The file for the class of 1861 contains a similar salt print series. Another noteworthy class series exists for the class of 1859. This lithograph series is virtually complete, consisting of four folders of images followed by one folder of autographs ("sentiments" written to Henry Stothoff 1859 by members of his class). The photographs for the classes of 1862 - 1873 are almost entirely in the form of cartes-de-visite. By 1873 the cabinet photo appears within the collection, and by 1878 it becomes the predominate form.

The final noteworthy photograph series is found in the class of 1879. William Notman, one of the most noted 19th-century North American photographers, created this cabinet photo series which comprises four folders. Notman, whose business originated in Canada, made inroads in the American school market and had contracts with Vassar, Harvard, Yale, and Lafayette.

20th-century photographs of students often exist as small yearbook shots in black and white until the 1970's. After this point, the student photographs are mainly high school senior portraits which were submitted to the Freshman Directory.

The group photographs of trustees, administrators and staff, faculty, alumni, and students are generally oversize and are consequently housed in oversize containers. A reunion photo of 1859 appears to be the earliest image of these photographs. With the exception of alumni and students, the photographs are arranged chronologically within each group. Alumni are organized into reunion classes, clubs, and miscellaneous groups. Students are organized by class, foreign groups, organizations, programs of study, and miscellaneous groups. Organizations are further arranged alphabetically and programs of study are separated into Liberal Arts or Science and Engineering.

Researchers should note that if an individual's photograph cannot be found in Series I, the albums of Series VI should be consulted as well for the years of the individual's association with Lafayette College. Photograph albums are listed in the index alphabetically by owner's last name and often contain photos of administration, faculty, and students as well as family portraits.

Series III (29 boxes) contains photographs of the campus and buildings of Lafayette College. Photographs are divided into campus views and buildings. The earliest image of this series is a 20th-century reproduction of an 1858 photograph of South College.

General campus views include photographs of the grounds as well as unidentified interior views of dormitory rooms. These photographs generally date from the late 19th-century to the present and are arranged by approximate date. Aerial campus views, dating from the early 20th-century to the present, are similarly arranged. It should be noted that some of the early aerial views are artistic renderings, and not actual photographs. Other campus views include monuments, plaques, statues, pre-College Hill locations, and various publications which contain photographic images. Publications are arranged alphabetically by title and date ca. 1894 - 1935.

Views of individual buildings are arranged alphabetically under present name and then chronologically within each group. If the name of a building has changed over the years, the photo will be filed under the most recent name with older names listed in parenthesis on folder headings. Because dormitory names were sometimes used on two buildings, "new" and "old" are used on folder headings to differentiate. Buildings which were located on Dormitory Row are filed individually for single shots and under "Dormitory Row" for group shots.

This series provides a valuable visual record of the physical changes which have occurred over the years on the Lafayette College grounds. Views of several buildings which have been demolished as the campus expanded include Gayley Hall, Green Observatory (the "Star Barn"), Dormitory Row, and West College. Several of the devastating fires the college has witnessed are well documented in this collection: the 1879 and 1897 Pardee Hall fires, the 1956 South College fire, and the 1965 fire in Colton Chapel. Constructions, renovations, and demolitions are fully recorded as well.

Series IV (29 boxes) contains photographs of Lafayette College life and activities from the mid-19thcentury to the present. The earliest photo of this series is a view of the college's display at the 1876 Philadelphia Exhibition.

This series is arranged alphabetically by event or activity and then chronologically within each group. Events which occur annually are filed under their own group heading. One-time events are located under Special Events, which includes some of the most noteworthy photographs of the series -- the college's anniversary celebrations of 1907, 1924, 1932, and 1976. Other noteworthy photographs may be found in Student Activities, including views of bon fires, the Banner Scrap, and the Cane Rush. Many of the photographs located within Classroom Scenes and Student Life are predominantly 1970's candid shots. Student Life includes photographs of students about campus, in recreation or study. The series includes photographs that were used in the college yearbook, *The Melange*.

SERIES V - ATHLETICS: CA. 1875 -

Series V (21 boxes) contains photographs of athletic teams and events at Lafayette College. A cabinet photo of the 1875 baseball team is the earliest image of this series. The series is arranged alphabetically by sport and then divided into men's and women's sports, and finally arranged chronologically. This series is dominated by men's athletics at Lafayette, as women's sports did not exist at the college until the 1970's. For this reason, the bulk of the photos are organized with men's athletics first, followed by women's athletics in a separate alphabetical arrangement. Photographs of the cheerleaders and the Lafayette mascot, the Leopard, are located within the series. These prints, similar to those found with the women's sports, are mainly modern black and white 8 x 10 shots dating post-1970.

Group photographs of athletic teams will be found in this series and not with the groups of Series I and Series IV.

SERIES VI - SPECIAL FORMATS: 1857 -

Series VI (89 boxes) contains special format photographic material. This includes framed photographs, albums, negatives, slides, stereocards and stereoscopes, and panoramic views.

One of the most valuable aspects of this series is the collection of 19th and early 20th-century albums (boxes 120-156). These albums, arranged chronologically, vary greatly in design and size. While most contain mainly cartes-de-visite and cabinet photographs of administration, faculty, students, and family, some of the larger albums house 8 x 10 views of the grounds, buildings, and student groups. Some of these class albums contain the only surviving copy in the collection of 19th-century photographs. Such rare photos are listed in the Index. The earliest piece in this series is a 1857 collection of portraits and views of Selden J. Coffin 1858. This album exists in two volumes and contains personal memorabilia relating to the college as well. Class albums dating 1878 and 1879 contain Notman photographs in excellent condition, some of which are the only existing copies in the collection. Albums covering the championship 1896 football team are found in this series and contain individual shots of the players in uniform and team shots. Other unique albums are housed here as well, including the three volume Book of Remembrance which commemorates those Lafayette students who died in World War II. Albums also include the 1945 inauguration of President Ralph Cooper Hutchison and the permanent residence of John Markle 1880 in New York City dating 1929.

Negatives exist in various sizes and formats. Boxes 157 - 158 contain individual negatives corresponding to Series I - V and are arranged similarly to the photographs in the series. Box 159 houses 5 x 7 negatives corresponding to Series III. Negative strips are found in Box 160. 8 x 10 glass plate negatives corresponding to Series II are located in Boxes 161 - 166 and are arranged alphabetically.

Slides are a major part of Series VI. Boxes 167 - 168 hold lantern slides which include an Admission's Office campus tour and miscellaneous events which are related to the college, such as the Easton Pageant of 1937 and an undated pageant in Avignon. Boxes 169 - 190 contain modern slides. The slides are organized into Admission's Office tours and Series I - V and arranged alphabetically by event or activity and then

chronologically which correspond to the photograph section. Some of the slides in Series IV are arranged by photographer.

Stereocards and stereoscopes are housed in Boxes 191 and 192 respectively. Panoramic views, which are group photographs taken on the Quadrangle, have been stored in extra-oversized folders. Cross-references to these panoramic views have been placed within Series II. Camera Club photographs from the 1940's are stored in Box 193.
